Congratulations! As a member of the West Falmouth Village Association, so far, you have helped raise \$18,860.04 to rebuild West Falmouth Swift Playground. Swings, slide, and a picnic table have been installed leaving approximately \$5000. This total includes funds donated by the West Falmouth Methodist Church for a bench to be installed with the next playground piece. I have also applied for a grant from Woods Hole Foundation. Fundraising for the approximately \$20,000 needed to complete the final phase begins now for two play pieces: an omni spinner (merry-go-round) and playhouse.
