WATER MAIN PROJECT / 28-A

With the start of spring, so starts the efforts to conclude the paving portion of this project. The town has stated its commitment to repave 28-A and Old Dock rd as well as the WF Dock area. This work is slated to begin this Wed and should all be complete before the summer rush.

WEST FALMOUTH MARKET

As you know, a village meeting with the owners of the West Falmouth Market was held a few weeks ago. Jeff Parish presented the plans and answered many of the concerns expressed by those residents and abutters in attendance as well as those comments sent via email. Overall, the reaction to the plans was positive and the desire to maintain the character of the village was strongly voiced. Significant revisions to the plan include a 2' reduction of the back roof line to preserve the presence of the store front on 28A, elimination of 1 apartment, enhanced closed circuit TV coverage to minimize loitering, no outside phone booths, and maintain ATM inside the building. Plans are displayed in the market for all to see.

BIKE PATH

Lawrence Lynch Corporation of Falmouth has been chosen and awarded the contract to construct the bike path extension through West Falmouth. Already crews are removing track to make ready for this effort. It is anticipated L&L will begin in June.
